Anthropology

- Is the scientific study of the human species. It is the exploration of human diversity in time and space. Anthropology confronts basic questions of human existence; how we originated, how we have changed and how we still changing. - Anthropology is a science of humankind. It studies all facets of society and culture. It studies tools, techniques, traditions, language, beliefs, kinships, values, social institutions, economic mechanisms, cravings for beauty and art, struggles for prestige. It describes the impact of humans on other humans.
