Educational Psychology

- The division of psychology that studies the educational process in schools including interactions among students, teachers and administrators. **(Ramalingam, Panch, Dictionary of Psychology, New Delhi: Academic Pub., 2002, Ref150.3 R165 2002 Reference Section, University Library)**
- One of the major professions of psychologists. In Britain practitioners are employed within the educational system to deal with psychological issues concerning children in school and to assess and monitor the progress of children with special needs. They are usually based on schools psychological services or Child Guidance Clinics. **(Stratton, Peter A Student Dictionary of Psychology, London: Edward Arnold, 1988, Ref150.321 St8 Reference Unit, University Library)**
- Educational psychology and school psychology study how children and adults learn, the effectiveness of various educational strategies and tactics, and how schools function as organizations. Although the titles are often used interchangeably, researchers and theorists are likely to be identified as educational psychologists, while practitioners in schools or school-related settings are identified as school psychologists. ***en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Educational_psychology***)
