Industrial Psychology

- The application of psychology to industrial situations. Industrial psychologists may study the effects of environmental influences on people at work; of organizational influences on people at work; of organizational influences, such as the effects of different management structures or styles; of social relationship within the industrial setting; or of sources of stress and industrial accidents. - The branch of applied psychology that is concerned with efficient management of an industrial labor force and especially with problems encountered by workers in a mechanized environment(1); the application of psychological principles and techniques to business and industrial problems, as in the selection of personnel or development of training programs (2); any of several branches of psychology that seek to apply psychological principles to practical problems of education or industry or marketing etc. (3).
